PROCEDURE

The Virginia Uniform Statewide Building Code requires that a backflow preventer be installed on each lawn irrigation system. This is to prevent lawn fertilizers, weed killers and other contaminants from being drawn back into the drinking water system. *An individual certified in installing backflow protection, a licensed plumber, or the property owner must install the backflow preventer.*


Please Note: The backflow preventer is required to be tested prior to inspection. <u>Reduced Pressure principal and pressure vacuum breaker backflow preventer</u> assemblies shall be tested at the time of installation. Please have a copy of the test available at the Final Inspection of the irrigation system
