February 2017 Meeting Minutes Winchester Regional Airport Authority

The Winchester Regional Airport Authority met in session in the conference room of the terminal building at 5:00 p.m., Thursday, February 16, 2017.

CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Gene Fisher called the meeting to open at 5:00 pm.

APPROVE MEETING AGENDA

Chairman Fisher requested approval of the agenda as presented.

Motion: Approve agenda as presented – Dave Reichert, second Paul Anderson. Motion passed.

APPROVE MINUTES - February 2, 2017 WRAA Special Business Meeting

Motion: Approve the February 2, 2017 WRAA special business meeting minutes as presented – Paul Anderson, second Bob Bearer. Motion passed.

COMMENTS – AUDIENCE - None

CHAIRMAN OPENING REMARKS

Chairman Fisher asked Paul Anderson to provide an update on a past board member. Mr. Anderson stated that prior WRAA chairman Arthur Fulton was in critical condition and urged members wishing to visit to do so without delay. He added that Mr. Fulton was at home being cared for by family and outside medical assistance. Mr. Anderson commented that Mr. Fulton had served as Warren County representative on the board since the formation of the WRAA in July 1987. In addition Mr. Fulton was the first chairman of the WRAA and remained on the board until he moved to Frederick County in 1999.

Chairman Fisher commented that he felt it was board members responsibility to keep their respective boards informed on the capital plans and budgets of what is in progress at the airport. Communication is key especially when airport staff requests funding for various capital improvement projects.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

a) Finance Reports – J. J. Smith, Secretary/Treasurer

Treasurer Smith presented the January 2017 financial reports. He stated the airport was slightly ahead on revenues. He questioned the difference in percentages of fuel costs vs. revenues. Ms. Manuel stated she would check those line items for explanation. Fuel sales were low in January but ahead of the same time last year. Mr. Pifer asked Ms. Manuel if she anticipated any unexpected large increases to the budget that would necessitate a supplemental funding request such as the substantial increase last year of salaries. She replied none that she anticipated at this time pending of course unknown repairs that may arise.

Motion: Approve financial report as presented – Paul Anderson, second Bill Pifer. Motion passed.

Bill Pifer asked what would be involved to begin marketing the north side by listing the property for lease. Ms. Manuel stated there were several items to consider were involving the construction schedule which had not yet begun. Adam Switzer was present and explained the pending construction schedule including the relocation of the gas transmission line. Ms. Manuel added that ground side access would not be built as part of the north side construction project along with infrastructure to move fuel trucks from the terminal side to the new site. Paul Anderson stated he felt marketing should be postponed until funding issues for capital and operating funding is resolved by the jurisdictions. Chairman Fisher commented that he had been working with leaders of the economic development authority to find an aviation related business that would want to locate at the airport.

DELTA AIRPORT CONSULTANTS, ADAM SWITZER, P.E. – NEW TERMINAL BUILDING STUDY

Adam Switzer, P.E. with Delta Airport Consultants and Rohn Price with Price Studios presented their assessment of the space needs for a new terminal building along with some exterior design schemes. Mr. Switzer explained the Department of Aviation's terminal funding program and what would be eligible for state funding. He added that this would be the first "replacement" terminal building funded by the DOAV if approved by the Virginia Aviation Board. Prior to the presentation he provided a brief history and justification for building a new facility and the site selection.

Mr. Switzer turned the meeting over to Rohn Price to present the potential layout of the new facility. Mr. Price explained the layout of all of the designated areas and their purposes. Several members asked questions and made suggestions on moving or swapping certain spaces for pilot's convenience. Mr. Price also explained what the various colors on the spaces represented such as areas eligible for State funding and those areas funded only by local funds. Several members provided their input on the space layout and Mr. Price reiterated that the space layout was definitely not the design the sole purposed was to determine how to maximize spaces for State funding and the funding percentages for budgeting. The current layout plan calculates to a State and Local funding participation level of 61.6% and 38.4% respectively. The rectangle shape of the new facility will allow for future expansion on either end. Mr. Price added the board of several airports to visit with recently built terminals that were designed by his company and Delta Airport Consultants. Following further discussion Chairman Fisher stated it was critical for localities that the WRAA is given the total project cost including building, site, utilities, etc. Mr. Switzer stated that they would incorporate member's comments into the final report which would be sent out some time in April

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR COMMENTS

Ms. Manuel stated that on February 28, 2017 the airport is on the agenda to address information requested by Council to justify the funding request for FY 2017. She invited WRAA members to attend in support. Chairman Fisher suggested that the after the decision on the funding request by City Council the City and County should meet to discuss future funding level participation. At that meeting Delta would be presenting the Business, Strategic and Marketing Plans.

CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Gene Fisher called the meeting to open at 5:00 pm.

APPROVE MEETING AMENDED AGENDA

Chairman Fisher requested amendment to the agenda to add presentation by Delta Airport Consultants for the Terminal Building Study Update under item 5 (a).

Motion: Approve amended agenda as presented – Bill Pifer, second Paul Anderson. Motion passed.

APPROVE MINUTES – February 16, 2017 WRAA Special Business Meeting minutes were not ready at the time of the meeting.

COMMENTS – AUDIENCE - None

CHAIRMAN OPENING REMARKS

Chairman Fisher stated that he had attended City Council meeting on February 14, 2017 along with Ms. Manuel, Bill Pifer, Paul Anderson and Courtney Beamon with Delta. He added that Ms. Beamon gave an excellent presentation to Council of the recently developed business, strategic and marketing plans.

DELTA AIRPORT CONSULTANTS – TERMINAL BUILDING STUDY UPDATE

Adam Switzer, P.E. Delta Airport Consultants started his presentation explaining that the study had been updated to incorporate WRAA board members' comments from the February 16, 2017 meeting. Rohn Price, Price Studios explained the changes incorporated into the space allocation plan and the conceptual drawing of the exterior that was favored by the board. He explained what changes were made and stated that the drawings were not indicative of a final floor plan. Both Mr. Price and Mr. Switzer stated that the new facility will be much more economical to operate and maintain. Chairman Fisher stressed to make sure when costs are budgeted to be sure to include all costs included with building and furnishing a new terminal complex.

Mr. Switzer stated that the final document would be sent it Ms. Manuel in two to four weeks for review prior to submitting to the Department of Aviation.

COMMITTEE REPORTS

a) Finance Reports – J. J. Smith, Secretary/Treasurer

Treasurer Smith presented the February 2017 financial reports reporting a profit to date increase he attributed to increased contributions from the City and County. Mr. Smith went over the yearend financial report for FY 2016 recently completed by the auditors. He added that he had reviewed the audit and found nothing out of the ordinary. Mr. Pifer asked why there was such an increase in salaries and Mr. Smith replied that it was probably due to vacant positions for most of the year. Mr. Pifer looked at the audit on the gross profit for fuel and asked for clarification regarding the percentage used in budget that fuel sales generates in the total revenue. Mr. Smith explained the difference between FY 2015 vs. FY 2016 on gross sales. Following discussion motion to approve was as follows:

Mr. Pifer stated that during the City Council meeting it was stressed by council members that the airport should develop a website. He asked if that process had begun. Ms. Manuel explained that the current year budget for promotional was committed for the development of the business, strategic and marketing plans. She said that funding through the Department of Aviation would not be available until after the DOAV meeting in August. Chairman Fisher commented that when localities request something outside of the normal budget process there are costs associated with it. It was the consensus of the board to put the website development as priority.

EXECUTIVE DIRECTOR COMMENTS

Ms. Manuel told the board that the VRA loan refinancing had fallen through the cracks while she was out for back surgery and upon recently discovering the issue she contacted VRA to finalize the arrangement. It was expected to be effective with the March payment at the new interest rate. Mr. Pifer asked for status on implementing the contract fuel program. Ms. Manuel said that the process was set aside because of workload relating to recent funding issues. She would try to have it accomplished by the end of April.
