




FY 2022 Advertised Budget - All Funds \$371,235,492 Where Does It Go?




FY 2022 Proposed General Fund Revenue \$209,706,798




FY 2022 Proposed General Fund Budget Expenditures \$209,706,798 Where Does It Go?

Employees - All Funds - History






School Operating Fund Revenues \$195,177,494

Transfer to School Operating Fund History





Population History (1940 - 2020)



(1940 - 2040)






Real Estate Tax Rates - History
