Command and General Staff Functions for Local Incident Management Teams is a five (5) day course aimed at Fire, E.M.S., Law Enforcement, Public Health, and Public Works personnel that are, or may be, assigned to an organized Local Incident Management Team with the purpose of improving their ability to manage (according to current I.C.S. principles and N.I.M.S. doctrine) an incident requiring a significant number of multi-discipline and/or mutual aid resources. Upon completion of the course, students will have an improved understanding of the purpose and function of each Command and General Staff position as well as the Planning Process. Completion of this course will also prepare and qualify the student to attend future All-Hazard Position Specific I.C.S. Course.
