Maintenance Activities:

Completed in December – Weather events and the holidays limited the amount of maintenance accomplishments this month. We were able to perform brush cutting on Rt. 50E. and Rt.7; Conducted grading operations and stone application on various non-hard surfaced roads; Performed shoulder repair on Rt. 636 and 627; Responded to pothole complaints and ditching needs on various routes throughout the County; Mobilized for weather events.

Planned for January – Continue with brush cutting along various routes; Continue with grading and stone application on non-hard surfaced roads; Replace cross pipe on Rt. 663; Repair potholes as they arise; Flush pipes along Rt. 707 (Hollow Road); Continue to mobilize for weather events and respond to citizen service complaints. All activities are weather dependent.

Major Projects:

On schedule – Sulpher Springs Rd., Advertise 2018

Welltown Rd. turning lane @ Rt. 11, Advertise February 2015

Rt. 11 S. Bnd lane add. @ Exit 317, Advertise February 2015. Public Hearing did not yield any major objections.

Rt. 522/Opequon bridge replacement, Advertise October 2014

Rt. 761/Opequon bridge replacement, Advertise December 2016

Rt. 277 widening - Still on schedule to advertise 2016. Current funding is short of current estimate. Have met with County Staff to discuss reduced scope.

Tevis St. – Comments on scoping document have been sent to consultant and revisions have been submitted.

Exit 313 Study – Currently in progress. Has been slowed pending resolution of discrepancies in modeling numbers. Still awaiting results.

Rt. 522/654 – Traffic Engineering moving forward with cab flashers.

Rt. 50/Poorhouse Rd. – Latest data does not meet warrant for signalization. Additional warning signage will be installed.
