

Sherando Park Rules and Regulations

1. Accidents and Injuries

Any person witnessing or involved in an accident in the park should call 911 for assistance.

2. Animals and Pets

Animals must be kept under control at all times. Pets must be on leash no longer than six feet. Owners are responsible for cleaning up after their pets. Pets are prohibited on or within 50 feet of athletic complexes, playgrounds, and swimming pool.

3. Digging or Excavating

Digging or excavating on park property is prohibited unless written permission is granted by the Parks and Recreation Director or his designee.

4. Conduct of Park Visitors

- No person shall damage, move or remove any park property, either man-made or natural.
- No Loitering
- The carrying or discharging of any fireworks, or explosives is prohibited.
- Boisterous, riotous, threatening, or indecent conduct or language shall not be allowed in the park.
- Fires are restricted to approved cooking and picnic grills and must be attended to at all times.
- Park visitors shall not enter, cross, trespass or disturb adjacent land or property.
- Motorized vehicles are restricted to designated roadways and parking areas. No private vehicles are permitted on maintenance access roads or on trails.
- Parking in areas other than those officially designated is prohibited.
- There shall be no feeding, hunting, molesting, trapping, harassing, or destroying of animals or wildlife in the park.
- No littering. Use receptacles provided.



Hiking Trail Key:

Trail	Length
Blue	1.2 Miles
Green	0.4 Miles
Red	0.8 Miles

Signs are positioned along trails to indicate the trail being walked and the distance. Trees along designated trails will periodically have a colored disc painted on them to indicate the current trail being used. All trails are circular and will return users to their original starting point.

Parking is available in parking lots adjacent to the pool area, Locke Gazebo, Lions Shelter, and Abex Shelter.
